



Supplementary Sailing Instructions

International Swedish Class Championship for 2.4 m R.

Date: 2018-06-29-2018-07-01

Organizer: Westerviks Segelsällskap och Westerviks Segelsällskap Wikingarna

1. Time schedule

1.1 Dates of racing: Friday 29 of june planned first warning signal 11.00
Saturday 30 of june planned first warning signal 11.00
Sunday 1 of july planned first warning signal 10.00

On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00

To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, an orange flag will be displayed with one sound on the race committee vessel at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

- 1.1 11 races are scheduled during the regatta.
- 1.2 The race committee will try to set lay the course so that a race will take approximately 45-60 minutes to sail.

2. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 2.1 The regatta office is located in the clubhouse of WSS at Solbergsudde.
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at a flagpole next to the clubhouse.

3. Marks

3.1 The rounding marks will be yellow cylindrical buoys.

New rounding marks when changing the course will be round, orange buoys.

The start marks will be two orange flag buoys. The finishing mark will be a blue flag boy.

4. Time limits

- 4.1 Race Time Limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 90 minutes.
- 4.2 Finishing Window is 20 minutes.
- 4.3 Mark 1 Time Limit for the first boat to pass Mark 1 is 20 minutes.





5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

- 5.1 The course is windward leeward with wing mark at the windward mark and gate at leeward. See attached sketch. The course will be sailed in 2 laps. The race committee may decide that it will be sailed in 3 laps. In that case flag T will be displayed on the race committee vessel at least 5 minutes before starting signal.
- 5.2 The classflag is E. This changes AppSF 6.1.
- 5.3 The race committee will not show the course as stated in AppSF 7.1. This changes AppSF 7.1.
- 5.4 A boat starting later than 10 minutes after her starting signal will be scored as Did Not Start. This changes RRS Appendix A4.
- 5.5 The starting line will be on the course side of the starting marks on the port side at the race committee vessel. This changes AppSF 9.2.
- 5.6 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the race committee vessel on the port side and the course side of the finishing mark at the starboard end. This changes AppSF 11.1
